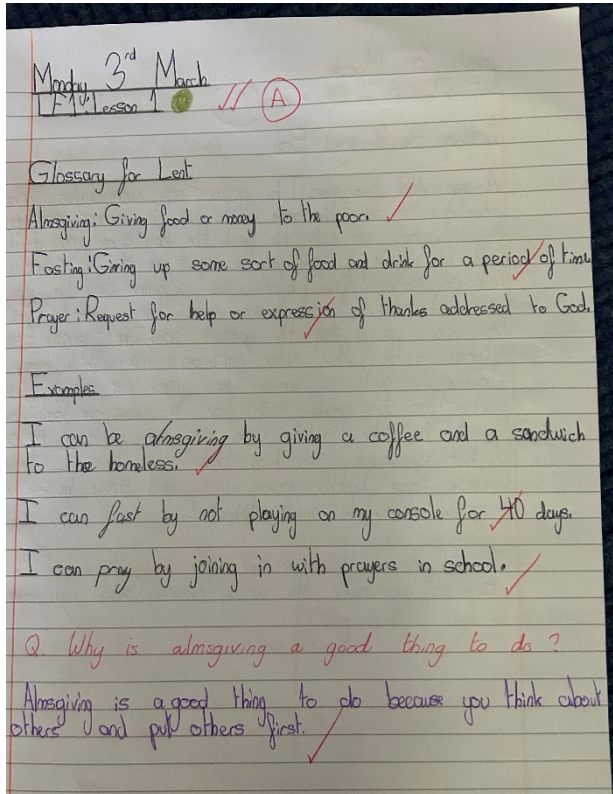


Learning Focus 1: Lesson 1



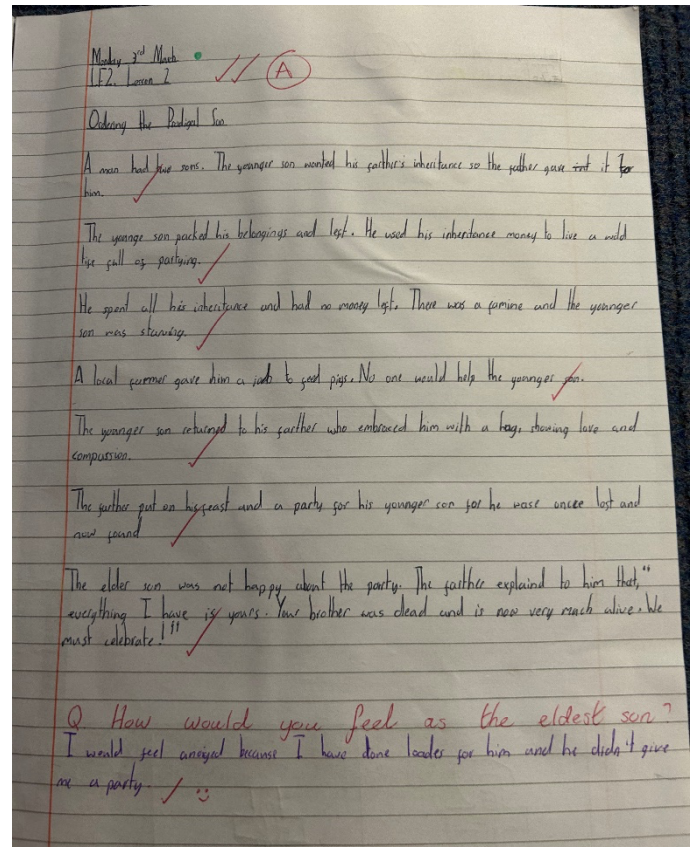
LO: I can make simple connections between the Church and living out 'works of mercy' and reflecting on what it is they need to change during Lent.

Children created a glossary for key words during Lent. They gave example how they can live out almsgiving, fasting and prayer.

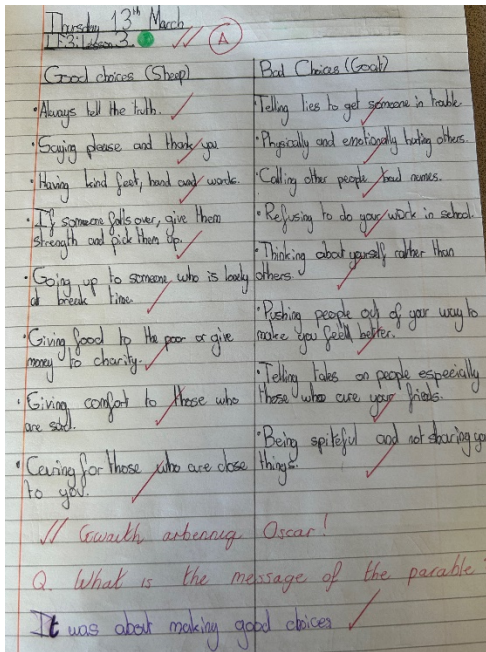
Learning Focus 2: Lesson 2

Learning Focus 3: Lesson 3



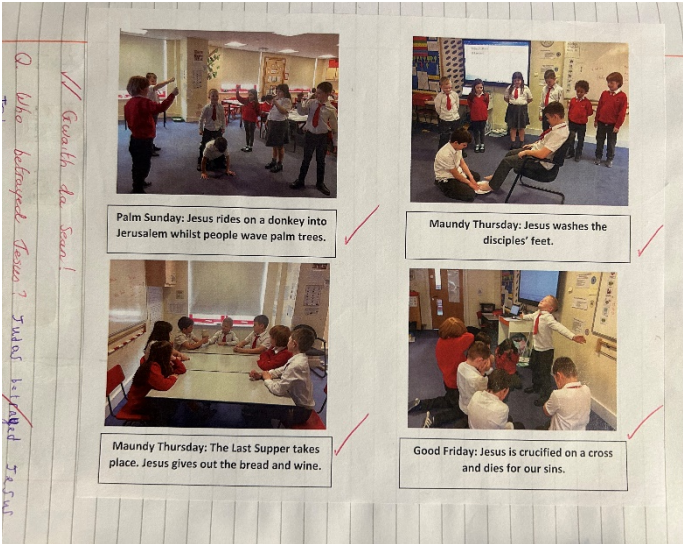
LO: I can make simple connections with the Judgement of Nations parable and the Christian belief that helping others is part of loving God.

Children sorted choices into good (sheep) and bad (goat) choices.

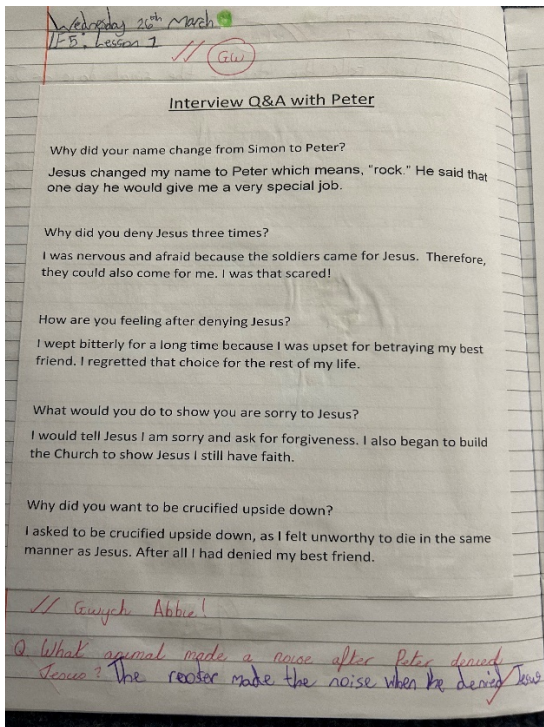
Learning Focus 4: Lesson 4

Learning Focus 5: Lesson 5
