RED - Galilee to Jerusalem

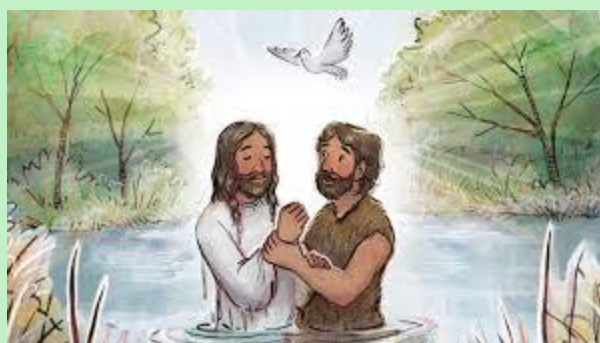
Holy Trinity
