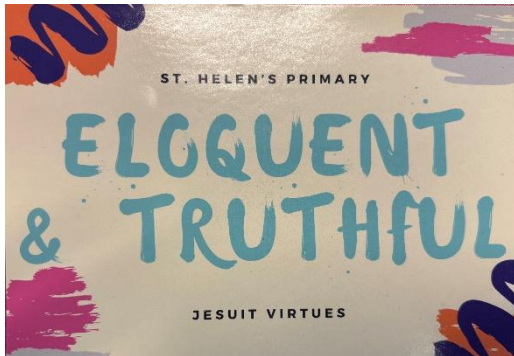


## Nursery Autumn Term - Virtues

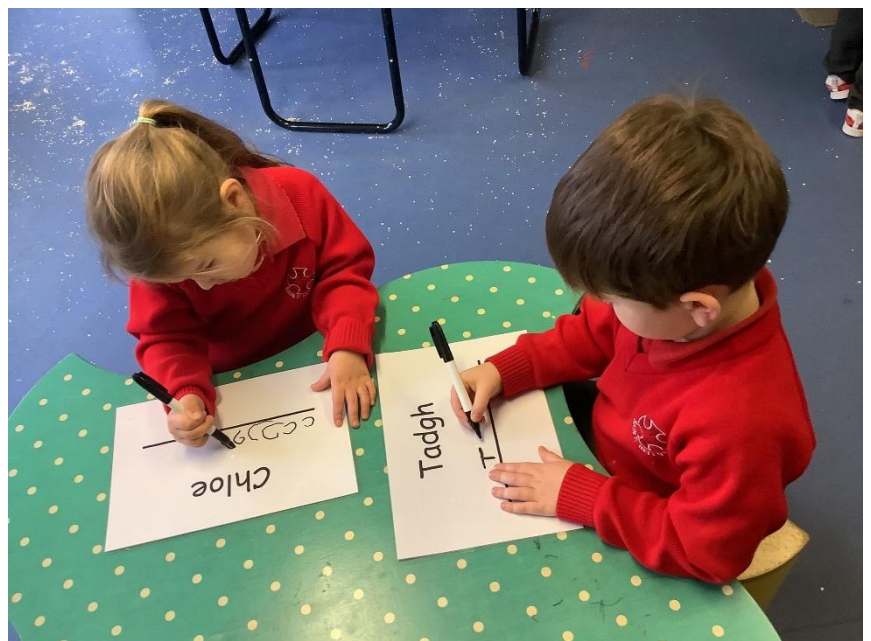
### Eloquent and Truthful



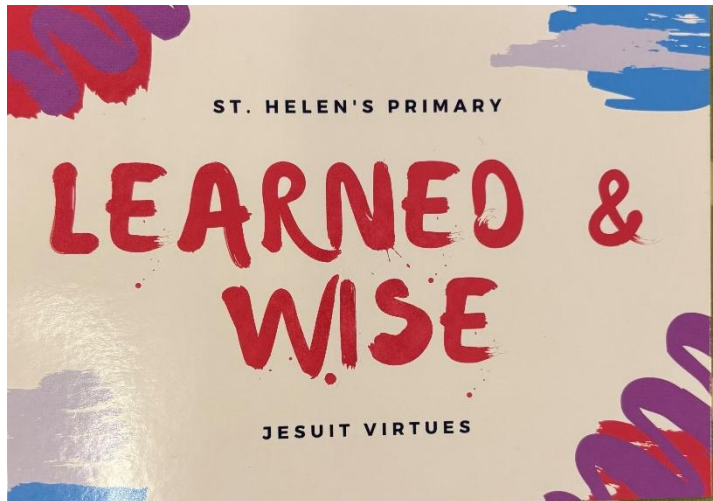

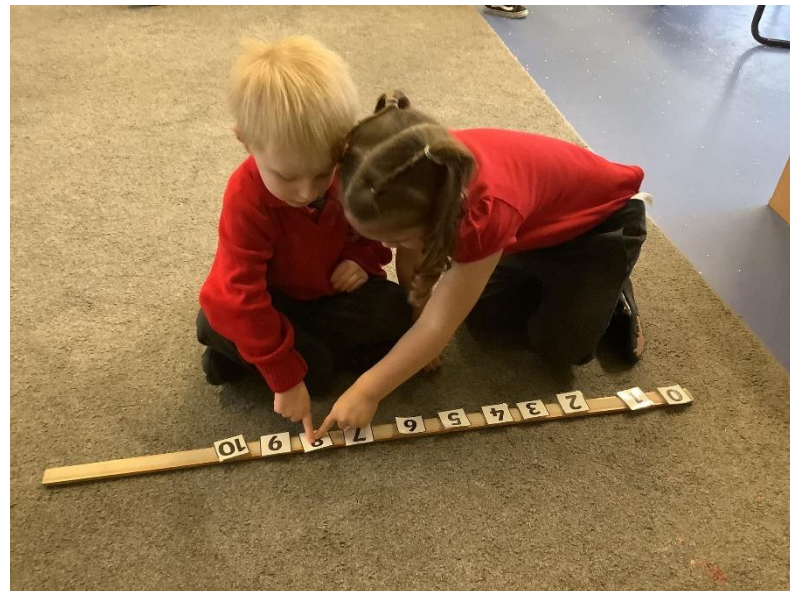
The children in nursery have been working on: being a good friend to one another, telling the truth and speaking and writing clearly.
