

Jesuit Virtues - Generous and Grateful

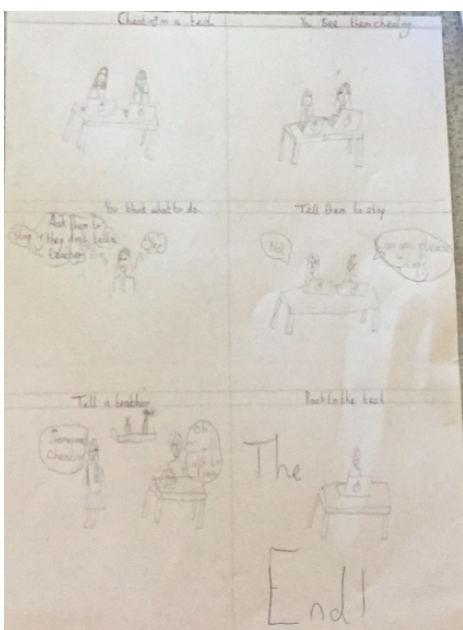


The children have been learning about the Jesuit virtues through assemblies, with a particular focus on being grateful and showing gratitude. They explored the importance of recognising and appreciating the blessings, opportunities, and people in their lives. As part of this learning, the children wrote gratitude letters to express their thanks to others and added notes to a gratitude jar whenever someone had shown them kindness or generosity. Through discussions and reflection activities, the children considered how they can both show gratitude and be generous towards others in their daily lives. This learning has encouraged them to develop a positive outlook, appreciate the contributions of those around them, and recognise the many gifts they receive each day.



Jesuit Virtues - Attentive and Discerning

Year 5 explored the Jesuit virtues of Attentive and Discerning through Bible stories. We learnt about Samuel, who listened carefully to God's voice, helping us understand what it means to be attentive. We also studied the Good Samaritan, who recognised someone in need and chose to help, showing the importance of being discerning and making good choices.



The children then linked these virtues to real-life situations they may face today. They created thoughtful and imaginative comic strips, freeze frames and dramas demonstrating how they can be attentive to others and discerning when making decisions in school, at home and in their community. The comic strips showed excellent understanding of how these virtues can guide us in our everyday lives
