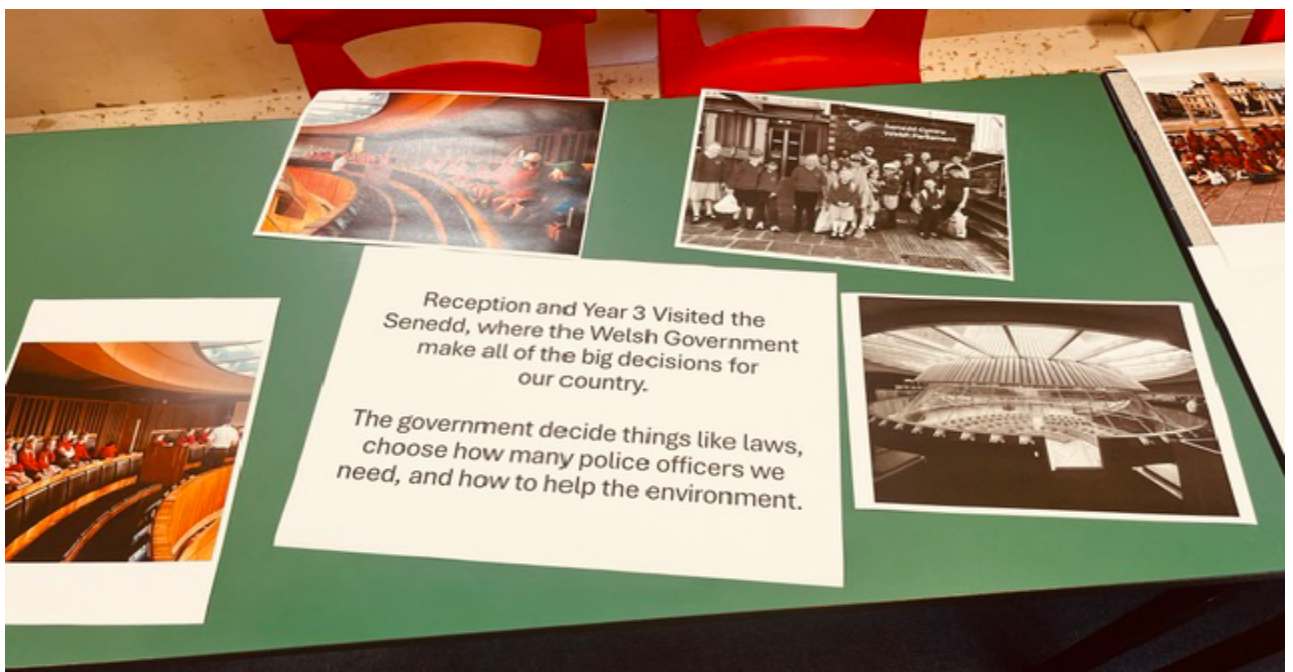
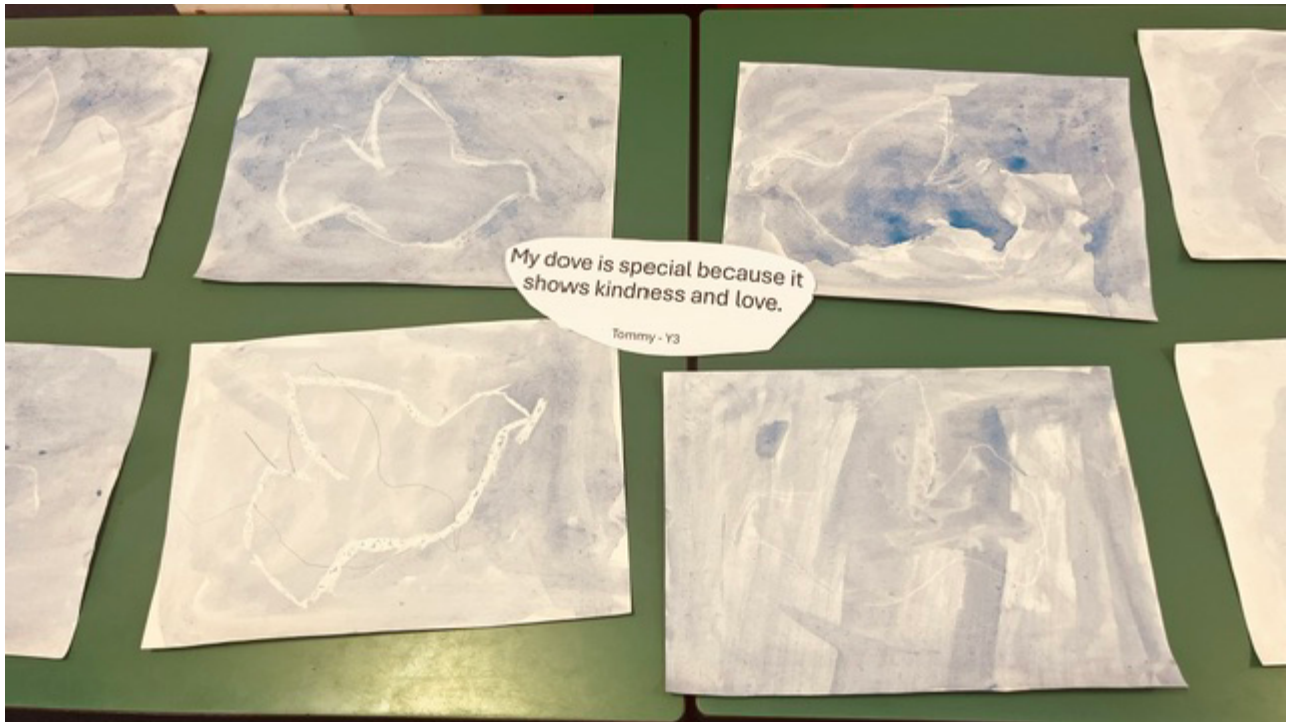


Year 3 Summer Term Virtues

Year 3 learnt about some of Jesus' important parables.



The Parable of the Prodigal Son teaches that everyone makes mistakes, but God always loves and forgives us when we are truly sorry. The father welcomes his son home with love, showing that everyone deserves a second chance. The story also reminds us to forgive others, show kindness, and celebrate when someone chooses to do what is right.

The Parable of the Sower and the Seeds tells the story of a farmer who scatters seeds on different types of ground. Some seeds are eaten by birds, some grow quickly but die, some are crowded by weeds, and some grow well and produce a good crop. The story teaches that God's word is like a seed, and people respond to it in different ways. When we listen to God, believe His word, and live by it, we can grow in faith and do good things.

The Parable of the Lost Sheep tells the story of a shepherd who leaves his ninety-nine sheep to search for one that is lost. When he finds it, he is filled with joy and carries it home. This parable teaches that God loves every person and cares deeply for anyone who is lost. It reminds us that everyone is important to God, and there is great joy when someone returns to Him.
