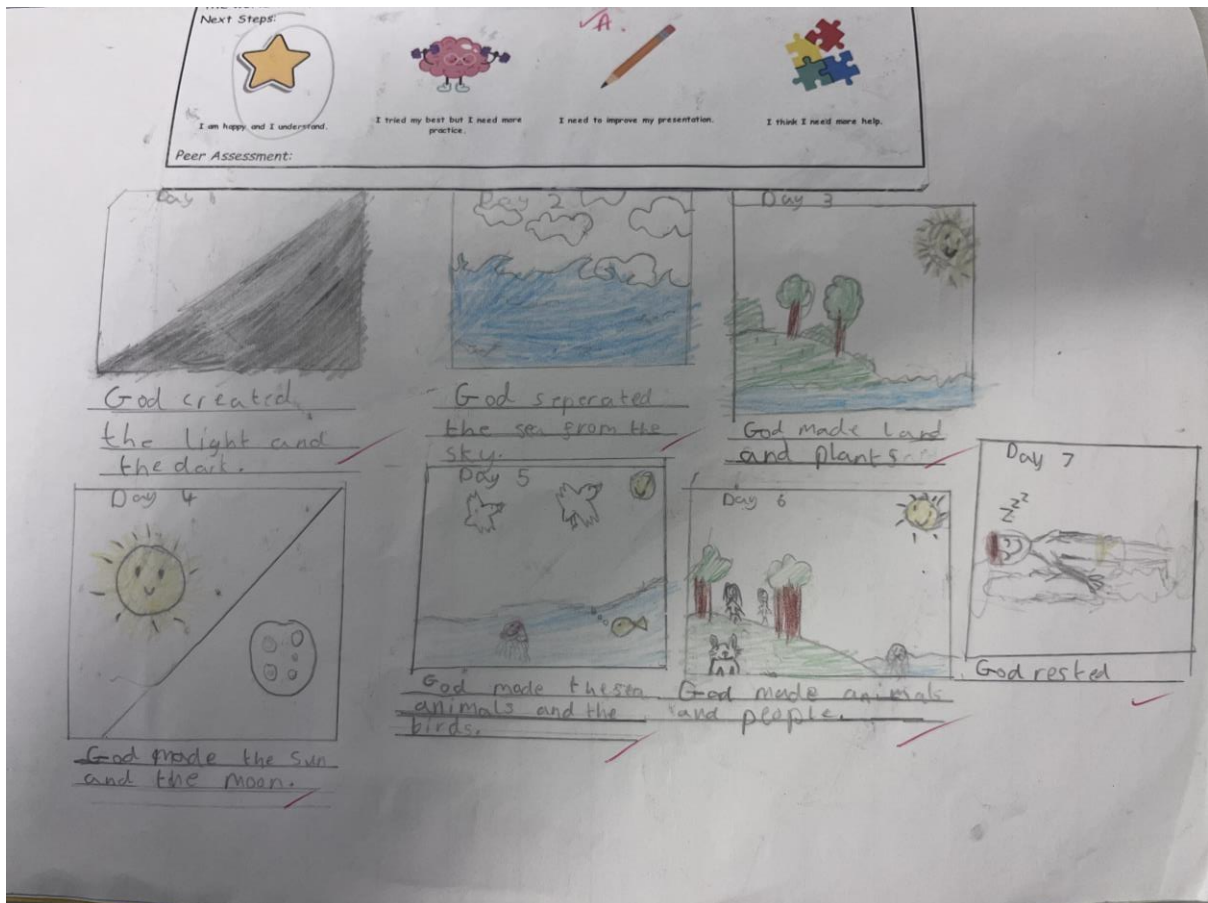


Branch 1

Creation and Covenant

We explored the Creation story from *Genesis* and discussed what it teaches about God, the world, and humanity's role within it. Pupils worked collaboratively to represent the key events and messages through posters, using images, captions, and short explanations to show understanding. We focused on big ideas such as the world being precious, human responsibility, and how beliefs influence actions. We then introduced covenant as a special promise or agreement and considered how people might respond to God's gifts through care, gratitude, and making choices that protect the world.

Prophecy and Promise

We learned about Isaiah's message of hope to the people of Israel and discussed why this promise mattered at a difficult time. Pupils explored how Christians believe this hope was fulfilled through the birth of Jesus, making links between the Old Testament prophecy and the Nativity story. They reflected on what "hope" and "promise" mean in real life and how beliefs can help people in hard times.
