- He was sent to Jerusalem where he became a Pharisee. They didn't like Christians.
- In his hometown with Paul was a bully. He would beat up all of these Christians in jail.
- On the road from Tarsus to Damascus, Jesus showed a bright light from the sky, questioning what Paul was doing. This blinded him for 3 days.
- When Paul regained his sight he got to know God by fasting and praying.
- Paul went around the world, new place, telling people about God and Jesus. He was a missionary.
- Paul wrote lots of letters about Jesus.
- Paul was willing to get beaten up, thrown in jail or killed as long as he told people about Jesus.

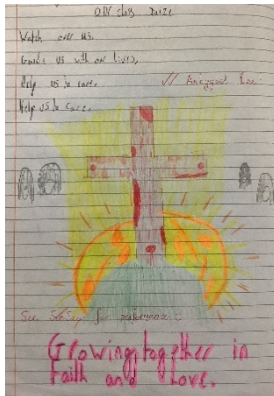

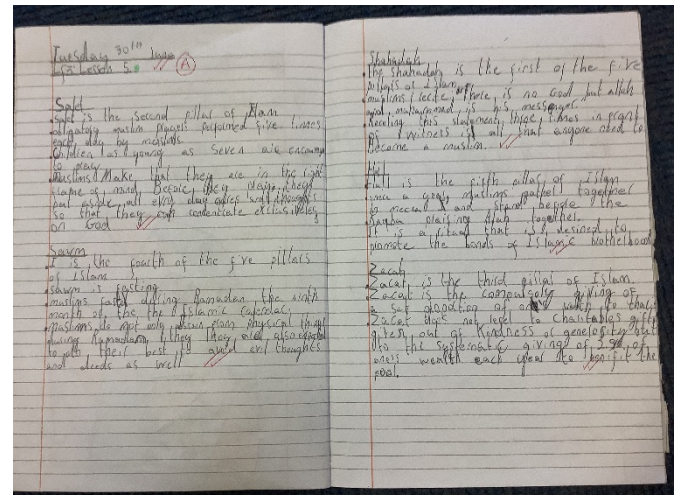
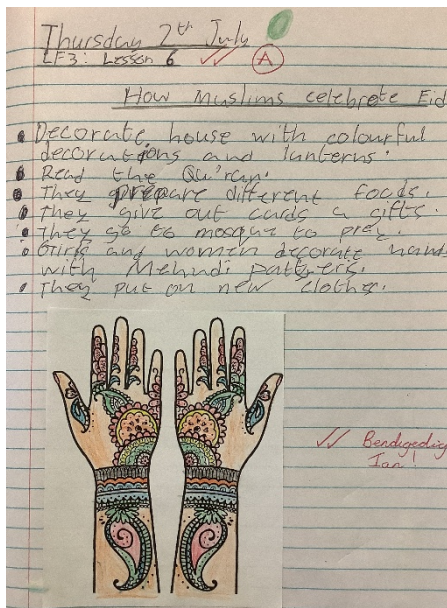
