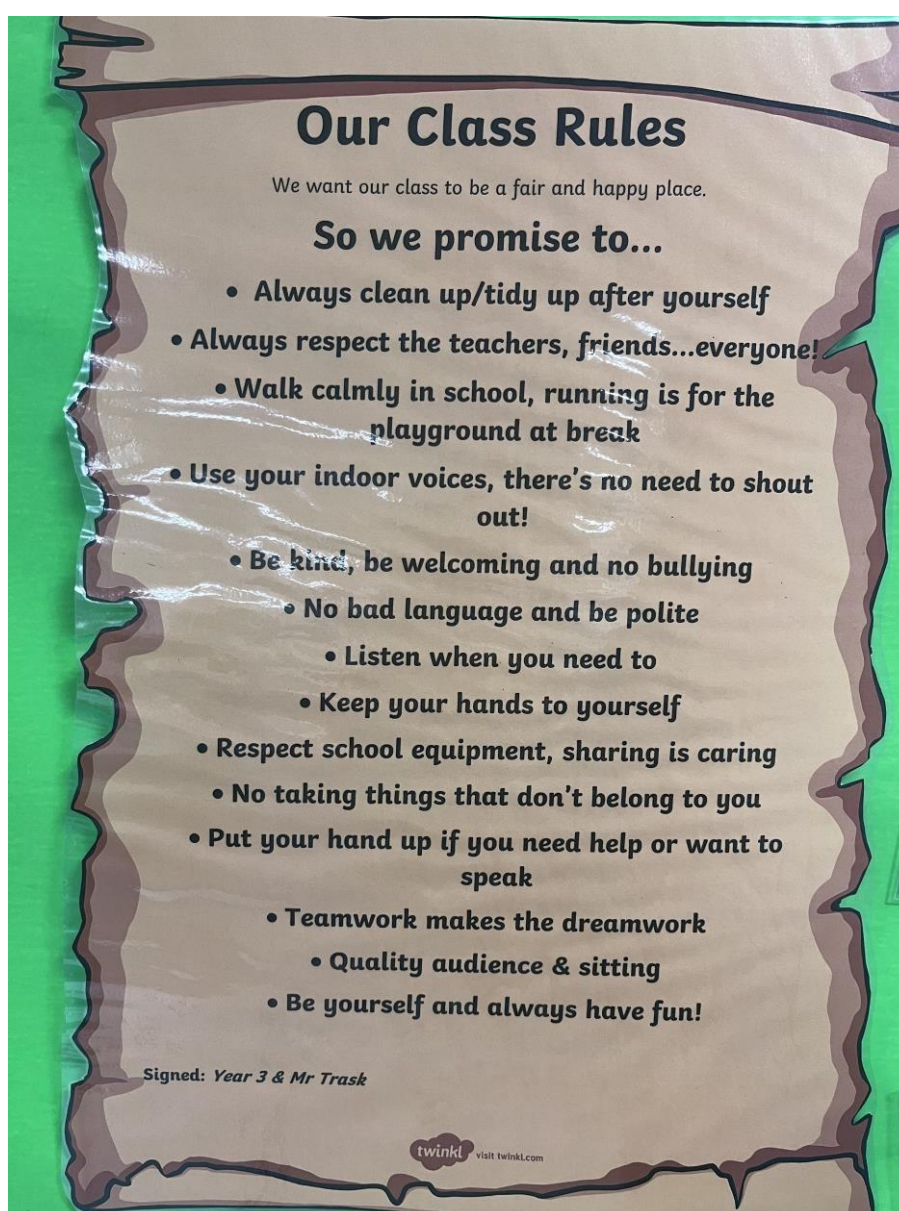


Eloquent and Truthful
