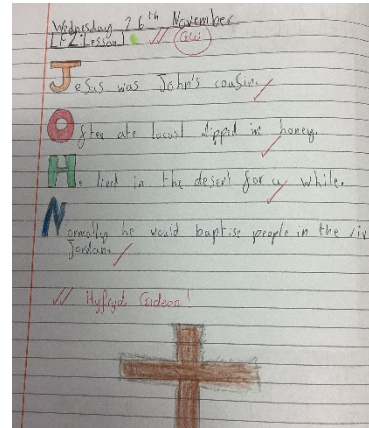

John was believed to eat fruit and vegetables.	F	His food was locust and wild honey. ✓

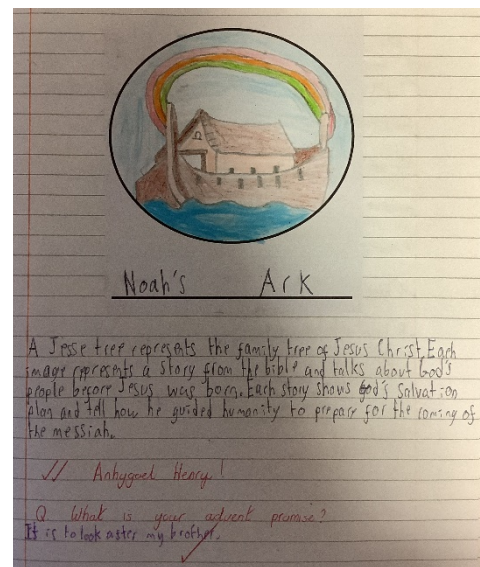
