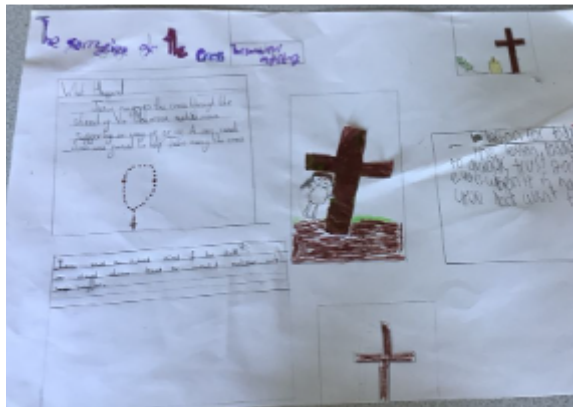
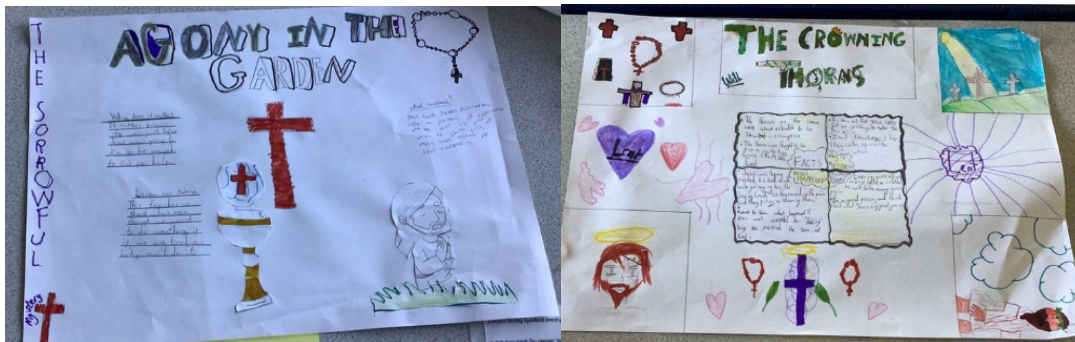

Year 5 RED Branch 4 – From Desert to Garden

In Branch 4 we learned about the journey from Lent to Easter and the events of Holy Week. We learned that Lent was a time when Christians prayed, fasted and gave to charity as they prepared for Easter. During Holy Week we remembered Palm Sunday, the Last Supper, Good Friday and Easter Sunday. Jesus died on the cross but rose again, which Christians called the Resurrection. This showed that God's love was stronger than death and brought hope and new life. Christians celebrated this in the Church at Easter and tried to live with forgiveness and faith.
