
Year 6 Summer Term Collective Worship

This Yr 6 Class mass celebrated Saint Athanasius. Saint Athanasius (born c. 293, Alexandria—died May 2, 373, Alexandria) was a theologian, ecclesiastical statesman, and Egyptian national leader. He was a great champion of the faith against the widespread heresy of Arianism, which denied the true divinity of Jesus. His writings earned him the title of doctor of the Church. As the bishop of Alexandria in Egypt during the 4th century, he played a significant role in shaping early Christian theology.



Entry Antiphon: In the midst of the Church he opened his mouth, and the Lord filled him with the spirit of wisdom and understanding and clothed him with the robe of Glory, Alleluia!

Psalm Response: The mouth of the upright utters wisdom.

heaven.

Eucharistic Acclamation: We proclaim your death, O Lord, and profess

your resurrection, until you come again.

Communion Antiphon: No one can lay a foundation other than the one

that is there, namely Jesus Christ, Alleluia!

It was lovely to celebrate Mass in school with some parishioners and family members.


Sunday 18th May – First Communion Mass
