This Yr 6 Class mass celebrated Saint Athanasius. Saint Athanasius (born c. 293, Alexandria—died May 2, 373, Alexandria) was a theologian, ecclesiastical statesman, and Egyptian national leader. He was a great champion of the faith against the widespread heresy of Arianism, which denied the true divinity of Jesus. His writings earned him the title of doctor of the Church. As the bishop of Alexandria in Egypt during the 4th century, he played a significant role in shaping early Christian theology.

*Eucharistic Acclamation:* We proclaim your death, O Lord, and profess  
your resurrection, until you come again.

*Communion Antiphon:* No one can lay a foundation other than the one  
that is there, namely Jesus Christ, Alleluia!

It was lovely to celebrate Mass in school with some parishioners and family members.

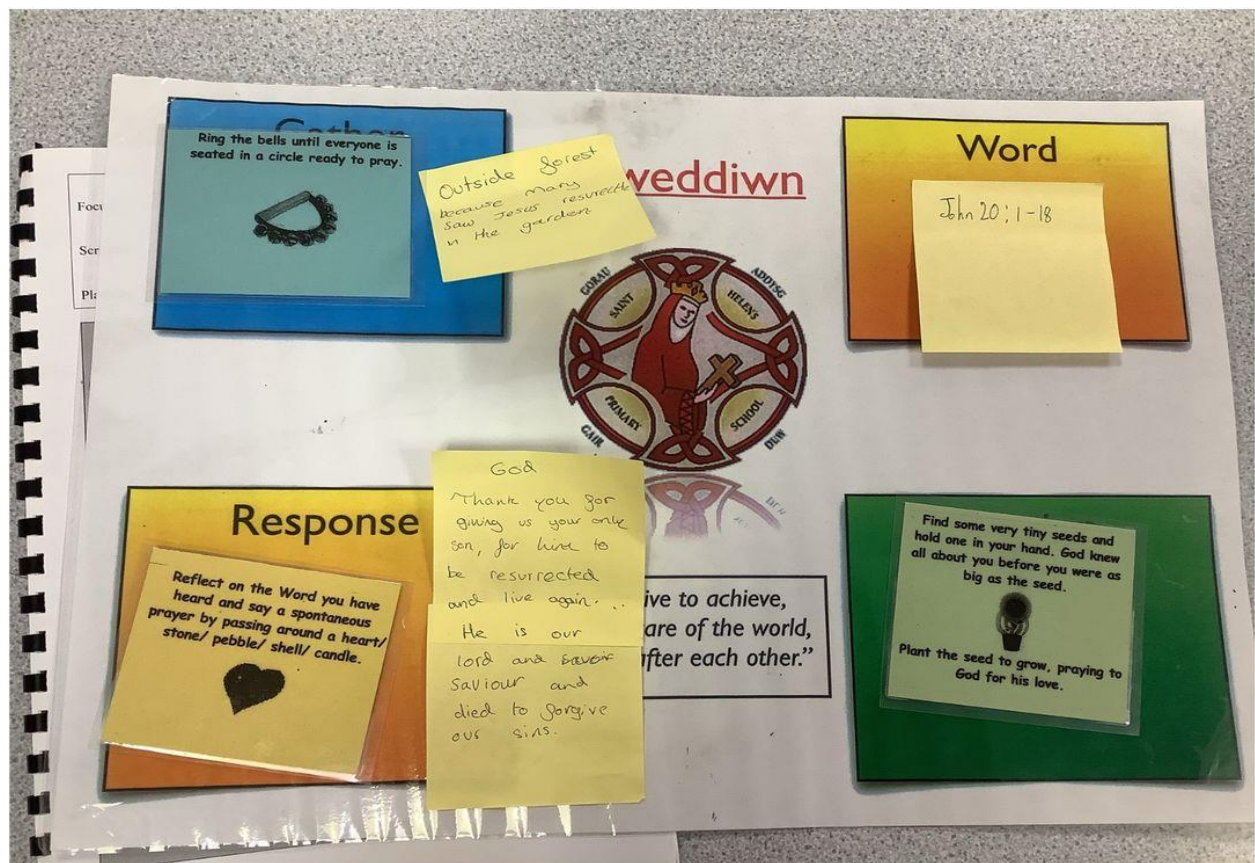
## Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> May – First Communion Mass
