

## Domestic Church – Family

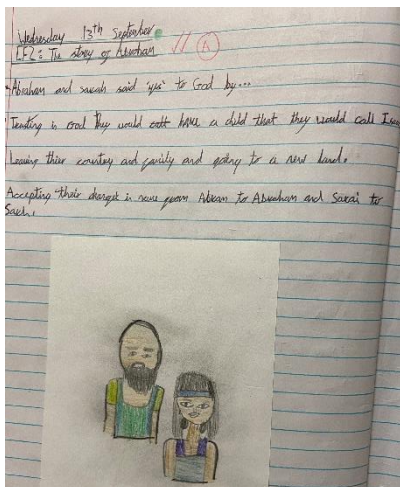
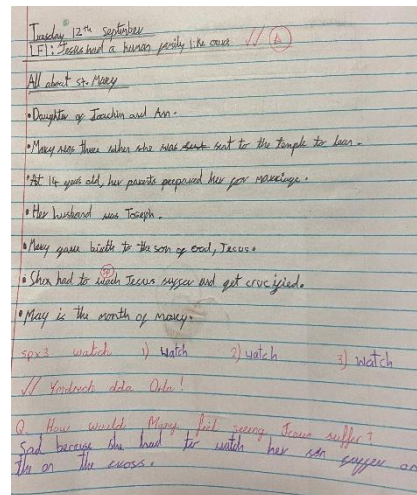
### Big Question: Where do I come from?

#### Explore:

Children researched information about Jesus human family. Through pupil voice, children chose Mary or Joseph. We made links orally how they are like our families.

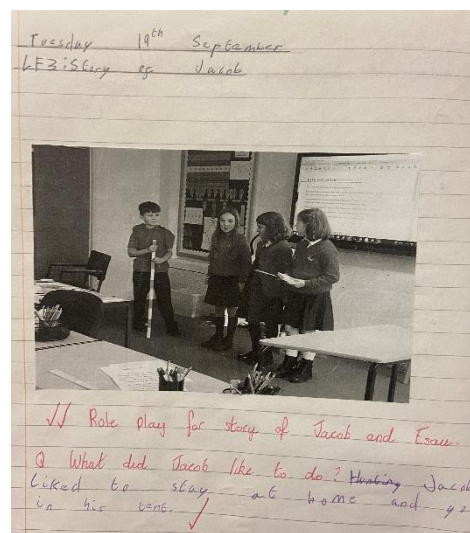


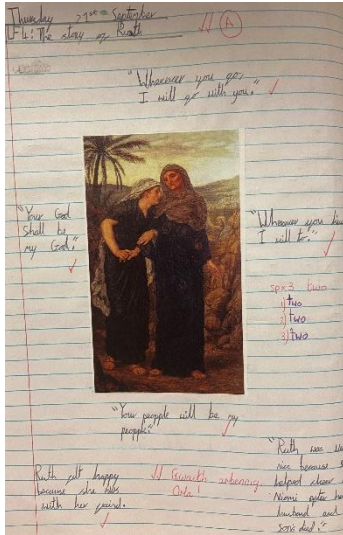
#### LF2: The story of Abraham

Some children did a role play acting out the story of Jacob and Esau. Other children did a character study of Jacob and Esau through a poster.



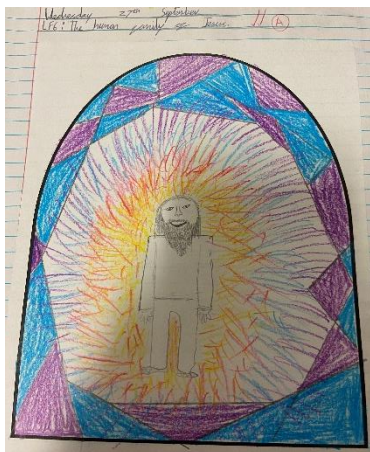
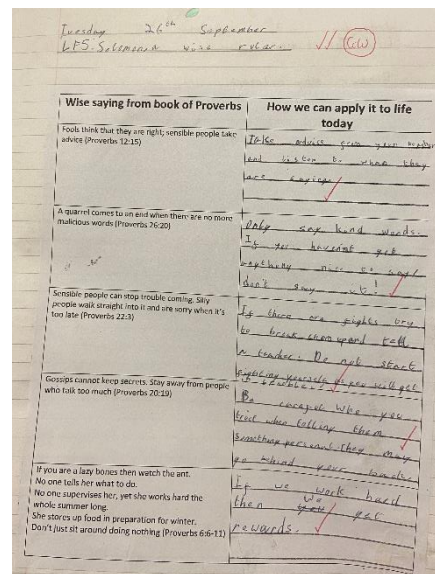


### LF4: The story of Ruth

One group of children asked questions to Ruth. Another group annotated a painting of Ruth and Naomi, describing what they would say. The final group created a code of living for how they can live their lives based on Ruth's actions within the scripture.

### LF5: Solomon, a wise ruler

Some children were given wise sayings from proverbs and had to apply them to life today. Other children researched their own wise proverbs and discussed their meaning. Other children wrote a response to why Solomon would be unhappy with the way we treat our planet today and came up with strategies how to look after God's creation.



### LF6: The human family of Jesus

Some children created a glass stained window for Churches representing Jesus' family. Some children researched all about the patron saint day of St. Joseph. Others gave reasons why Joseph was a good family man.
