Low Risk(L)-Something, which may result in minor damage or slight harm (i.e. scratch or bruise)
Medium Risk(M)-Something which may result in a significant loss/damage or major injury (broken bone or injury which results in person being taken to hospital for treatment)
High Risk(H)-Something which may result in extensive damage, multiple major injuries or death.
