

Year 5 Collective Worship

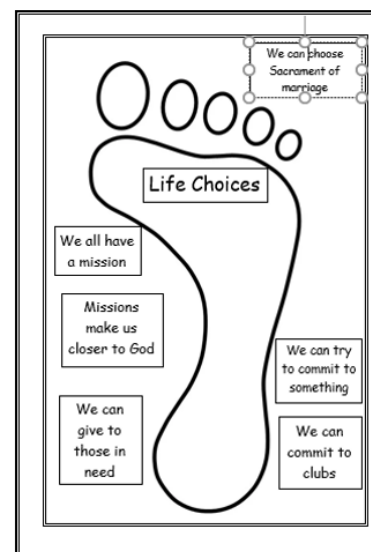
Ourselves - We remembered, celebrated and responded to a deeper awareness of "who am I?"

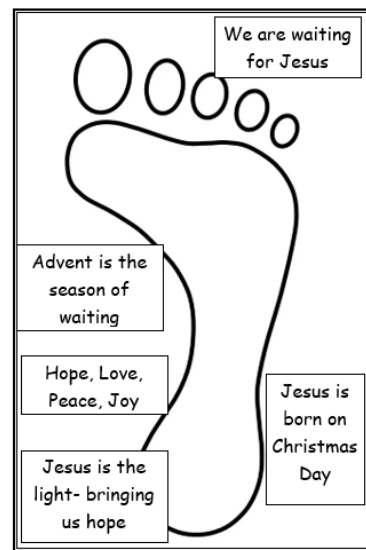
