



LF2: The Parish Community Some wrote a prayer for our local community. Other children researched information about St. Helen's church.

LF3: How people within the parish serve the community in church.

Children did a matching and sorting activity. Children had to match the role within the Church with a photograph of it being carried out. For example, flower arrangers, collectors, and organists.






LF4: Ministries in the Parish

Some children researched day to day people who help in our community e.g. visiting ill people in the hospital. Other children wrote a prayer for those who serve in the community. Some children looked at a 'what if' scenario which was 'What would the parish community be like if no one served?'

LF5: Joining together as a community

Some children wrote instructions how to be a good person to the community. Some made links to scripture how they can be good to the community.
