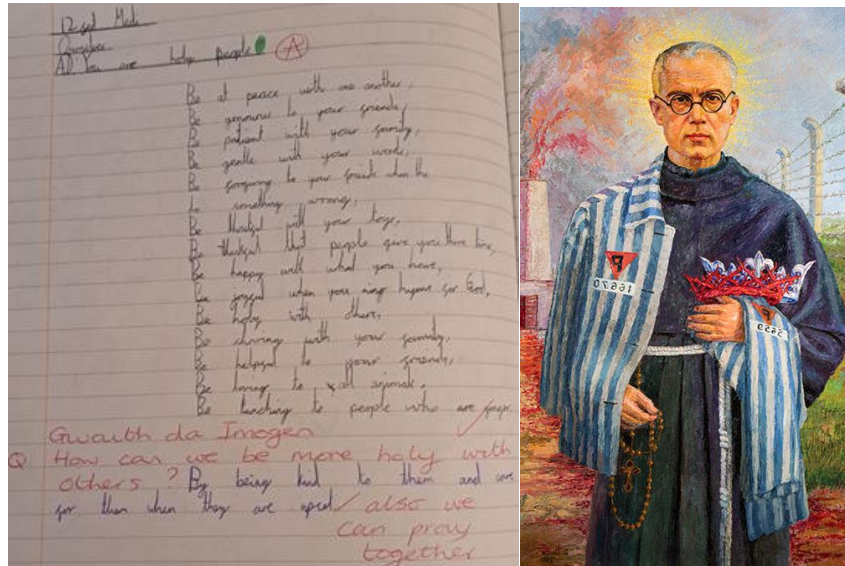


Year 5 RE

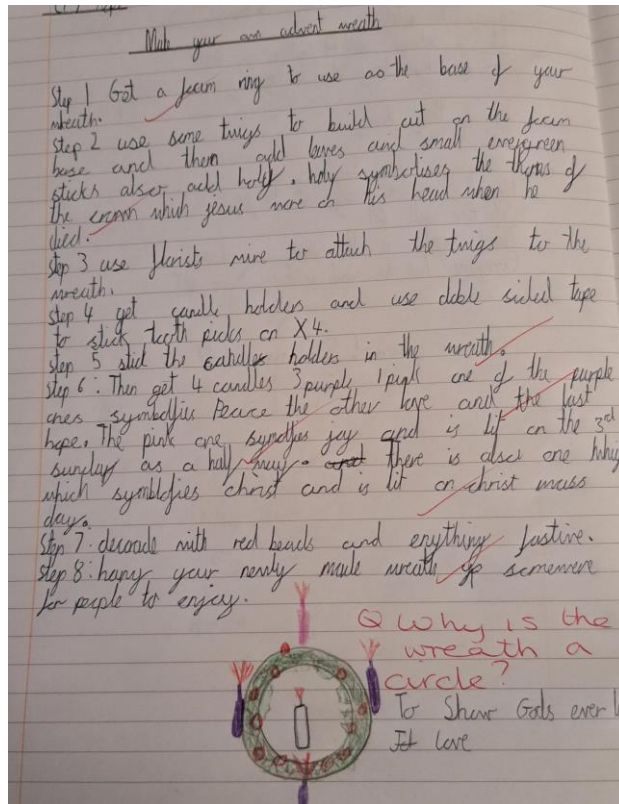

We enjoyed independently considering this as we carried out various tasks - including analysing the promises made during the Sacrament and identifying the symbols and actions during the Sacrament of Marriage.

We wrote instructions to make our own advent wreath, we made links with Jeremiah 33: 14-16 with the hymn Servant King and Christ be our Light. We collaborated online to create our own Advent Calendar and also used Misso Advent Calendar daily for collective worship.
